ABOUT JAKE GREEN:

At just 16 years old, Jake Green is recognised as one of the most promising new talents in British motorsport.

Winner of the Junior Gearbox Championship in 2007, Jake has gone on to win both the Shenington Kart Racing Club Summer Championship 2008 and the Lincoln Kart Racing Club Winter Championship 2008, racing with far more experienced drivers in the senior 125icc class.

Jake's career in motorsport started at just nine years old and it wasn't long before he was outperforming his older rivals in karting with fastest laps.

Since then, Jake's been talent-spotted by leading names in motorsport as well as attracting national media coverage.

Anthony Hieatt - team principal to F1 world champion Kimi Raikkönen's team Raikkönen Robertson Racing and Julian Rouse, team principal of Fortec Motorsport, describe Jake as a natural talent.
