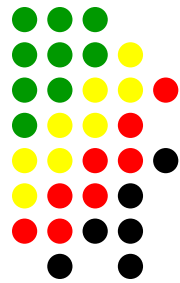

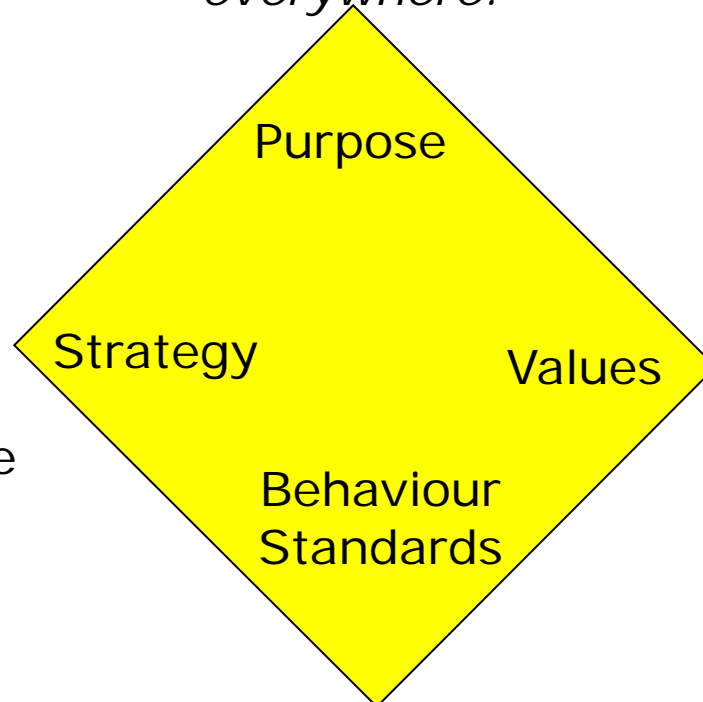


THE NYOI MISSION

Middle Eastern identity, intercultural, innovative, future oriented, sharing Iraqi culture through sustainable partnerships

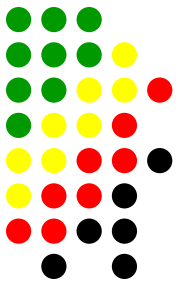

Outreach 2010

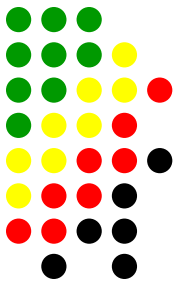


- Auditions via youtube are now on for Summer Course 2010

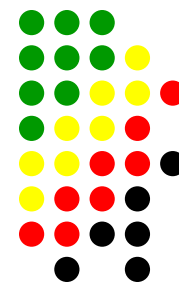

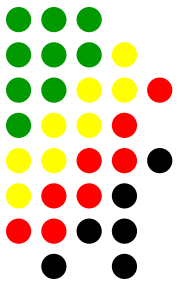


For the whole tour from Baghdad to UK and home: £150,000



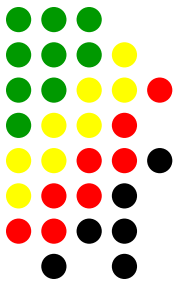
