To offer an alternative form of therapy which will enhance their treatment and inspire others to start the voyage to their own recovery.

What's the benefit of this project?

Sailing the Tectona is hard, physical work involving team-work and a commitment to learning new skills. The service users would be involved in every aspect of running the ship, day and night. Professional crew provided by The Island Trust (a sail training charity) will ensure safety, teach techniques and encourage service users to reflect on their experiences on a daily basis.

Sail training is proven to increase individual's self-esteem and confidence, it enables service users to gain awareness of one another and learn how to work as a team to achieve a common goal.

Each service user would also obtain a RYA competent crew certificate which is a recognised qualification and a great starting point for anyone thinking about a career in sailing. This project will open up the world of sail training, and the benefits that come with it, to many people who wouldn't normally have such an opportunity.
